Transforming Norwich Annual General Meeting - July 2017

Transforming Norwich has continued to deliver regular activities and events throughout 2016/17, and the work of this past year has been summarised below.

Transforming Norwich aspires to help equip, encourage, and empower by:

- Facilitating and encouraging the process of churches in Norwich growing together in worship, witness, service and evangelism.
- Assisting and encouraging churches in a variety of areas including evangelism and social action.
- Being a voice for all the churches and provide an effective communication network.

Ministers Together Lunches

Ministers Together Lunches have continued to take place on the first Wednesday of each month providing the opportunity for Ministers and Ministry leaders to get together, be strengthened and encouraged and to demonstrate unity and love for each other over sharing lunch and an informal time together.

Prayer

A team from Transforming Norwich supported Jill Gower from Call to Prayer to help organise the **Global Day of Prayer** at Norwich Cathedral where a few hundred people gathered to join millions of Christians across the world praying together in June 2017.

This year the focus of prayer was around the 7 pillars of society, and there were two breakout times for people to spend time at prayer stations. The 7 pillars of society were; family and community; civic authorities; health; education; business and commerce; media and arts; church and ministries.



We also have regular prayer events, including **Transforming the Atmosphere** which meets monthly at House of Prayer, and **REVIVE** monthly prayer meetings meeting at Alive House.

These times have provided the opportunity to come together to pray specifically for the City and County.

Mission and Social

Transforming Norwich continues to give support to both **Celebrate** (annual event which takes place in Norwich and Kings Lynn to celebrate, demonstrate and communicate the work of the Norfolk Christian Community), and also **Network Norfolk** (which provides a communication platform for churches, ministries and organisations to share about their work across the County).

At Celebrate in June 2017 Transforming Norwich supported Charities ENYP and Hope into Action to take part in the Norfolk feeding 5000 initiative. The Charities provided food - croissants, smoothies, soup, milkshakes, bread, banana bread, and fresh fruit and vegetable picnic project bags - and fed over 1200 people in 4 hours during the Celebrate event! The simple act of demonstrating love through the provision of free food led to some amazing conversations and the opportunity to share God's love and reach out and engage with people in a practical way.





INCREASE Youth Conference

In November 2016 ENYP, Norwich Youth for Christ and Transforming Norwich hosted INCREASE - a youth

conference designed for youth leaders and volunteers to be equipped and explore evangelism in order to 'increase' God's Kingdom.

Over 120 delegates during the two days heard from key note and seminar speakers, both national and local, including: Sam Ward (Message Trust), Matt Summerfield (Urban Saints), Dr Kate Middleton (Mind and Soul), Phil Timson (Hope Revolution), and Bethany MacDonald (The Naked Truth Project). The conference explored key topics including emotional

health and wellbeing, pornography, the changing nature of schools work, discipleship, the challenge of youth ministry, calling and purpose, and evangelism.

Danny Doran-Smith, ENYP Director and Chair of Transforming Norwich said, "Increase was our first youth conference in the City, and one which will we will build on next year. The opportunity to unite together to deliver this with Norwich Youth for Christ was a privilege, and we know that in unity God commands a blessing. We've received some great feedback about the conference and look forward to planning next





year's conference. May the next season be a great season of multiplication in God's Kingdom".

Nick Blanch, Director of Norwich Youth for Christ shared; "What a powerful couple of days! We had some incredible talks and seminars that were challenging, filled with inspiration and gave practical wisdom in the ministry of young people. I believe it was also highly significant that we came together as a united group of people in prayer and worship to cheer each other on and pray for the young people of Norfolk - I look forward to what comes next!"
